He received his Senatorship from the Chandler Jaycees in 1981, and was President of the Arizona Jaycees in 1983-84.

Gary Wayne Boesch, JCI Senator #49412, AZ Life Member #57, passed away on Friday, June 14, 2019. He was 68 years old and received his Senatorship from the Tempe Jaycees in 1992. Gary's membership in Mensa International landed him in Who's Who in America, but it was other things in life that were important to him. Gary loved to fish, paint faces, write poems, sing songs, enjoyed a corny joke and was known to fight blazing heat to squeeze-in a round of golf. Gary's time on the Minnesota farm taught him to live within his means, be resourceful and outsmart his older brother and a cranky pony. His time at Arizona State University taught him to be

a civil engineer and his time at the West Point Army Academy taught him how to be an officer, a man and to serve his country. Serving was the crux of Gary's soul. Active in volunteering and the Arizona Jaycees for many years, Gary, awarded a Jaycee "Rooster" at age 40, was dedicated to fostering leadership skills and personal development for young men and women. He was honored and beamed with pride when he was selected to carry the torch in Arizona for the 1996 U.S. Olympic Games. The family asks that in lieu of flowers and in honor of Gary, you donate to the Jaycees, the American Diabetes Association or to another worthy organization that can make a difference to someone's life.
