Your AZ JCI Senate started this program in 1995. It entails picking up trash and debris on Rio Salado Parkway from McClintock Road to Rural Road, about one mile. We do it twice each year usually in May and October when the weather is best. The City of Tempe provides us with trash bags, safety vests, instructions primarily about safety and Jim "Slick" Hampshire lends us his pickers. It takes us about one hour to do the job. The bags containing the trash are left for the city to dispose of

and then we adjourn for lunch and a social.

On October 20 we met at what is now known as parking lot 8, across the street from the entrance to the Carsten golf course. We found that quite a bit of landscaping had been done and as a result there was less trash than what we usually find. We did partially fill about ten bags of stuff however and could see a noticeable improvement in the appearance of Rio Salado especially when you consider that one paper plate, grocery bag or similar item blowing in the breeze can be quite obvious and have an uncleanly appearance.


